Dear Sustaining Partner,

We are encouraged to choose life through Jesus, enjoy and protect all children and share the truth—Life IS sacred no matter what anyone else may say. Recently I viewed a YouTube someone sent me of an interview with Virginia Ironside in Great Britain. Ms. Ironside stated, “Any good mother would put a pillow over the face of her suffering child and smother it.” Philosopher, Pete Singer of Princeton University agrees, and in fact goes just a little further.
