Over 40 years ago when thinking, discerning people realized the Roe vs. Wade decision was going to change our society for ill, they banded together to begin this ministry. At the time general, "crisis" pregnancy counsel and information was the only required service. Of course, since then many factors including acceptance of abortion, decline in moral absolutes, unemployment have contributed to the neediness of our child-bearing population. As changes occurred in our community, we've changed and grown to provide more and more of what is needed to make LIFE-the first choice.

Over the past nine years we've needed to make many more changes including an increase in the hours of operation, more comprehensive services delivery, numbers of volunteers, training requirements and of course—events. It takes a lot of resources to provide services and meet even some of the needs of over 3,000 women and families each year. Although many choices to abort are made from a selfish motive, many young women think abortion is their only viable option. We check out our resources very carefully and whenever possible, visit to ensure we send our families to people who will value them as we do. We're very protective, and we take our calling from God to care for "the least of these" very seriously. It pleases us to know that God's people are everywhere and available to partner with us to reach people with The Gospel and to provide help and healing in many other practical ways.

One of the major blessings for all of us in the past few years is our growing relationship and mutual respect with Christian comedian, Nazareth (Riskallah). He has done a couple of events for us to help to raise funds and increase awareness for our ministry. *Keynote Speaker for Fall Gala*

*Carol Everett* is unique "at such a time as this" because she comes with an overwhelming amount of experience in the area of pregnancy termination. Carol knows firsthand about pregnancy termination, having been both a consumer and provider. Carol was involved in the operation of four pregnancy termination clinics from 1977 to 1983, overseeing 35,000 pregnancy terminations. Carol experienced a change in her life when she came to know Jesus Christ as her personal Savior. Today, she is committed to safeguarding the health of women and their babies all over this nation. She also speaks to the men and women who have experienced a pregnancy loss to offer a message of healing and hope.

Carol has been invited to share her incredible testimony on many national broadcasting programs, and she has the distinction of being summoned as an expert witness in courts of law throughout our nation, testifying in Washington D.C. and numerous state capitals regarding the harmful, lasting impact of abortion in our nation.

Carol is president and founder of The Heidi Group. The Heidi Group was formed to network Resources for Women/Crisis Pregnancy Centers across the nation and offers services to the centers such as board strategic planning, fundraising, volunteer training, continuing education, etc. The Heidi Group has a prayer ministry joining Christians to pray for salvation of those in the pregnancy termination industry, strength for believers and the end of pregnancy termination. The Heidi Group produced and airs pro-life television commercials. These commercials have aired in San Antonio, Austin, Waco, Dallas/Ft. Worth, and several other states. Women's Resource Centers/Crisis Pregnancy Centers are experiencing a 30% increase in calls and as high as 70% increase in Hispanic calls when the ads are airing.

Carol's life story is detailed in the book, *Blood Money – Getting Rich off a Woman's Right to Choose*. The ministry has also released two videos, *The Light of Life* and *Abortion Techniques*.

## *Employee Spotlight*

Ultrasound technologist Beverly Beckley gets to meet an unborn child at the same time the baby's parents do.

Beverly, who attended Loma Linda University, previously knew about the Pregnancy and Family Resource Center and wanted to volunteer there one day. She was laid off after more than 25 years, and decided to see if the center needed an ultrasound technologist.

"The day I visited the center, a doctor was also visiting to offer to pay for a technologist to work 20 hours a week," she says. "They offered and I accepted."

She started at the center in the middle of February and works four hours, five days a week.

"From Day 1, I have felt as though I fit right in," she says. "Everyone is friendly and helpful." She performs non-diagnostic ultrasounds, allowing a couple to hear their baby's heartbeat "even before they can see them," she says.

Being able to give future parents "a connection to the reality of their baby can save the life of a baby," she says. On the other end of the spectrum, she says it's challenging connecting abortion-minded clients who don't want to look at the screen to their babies.

"Too many babies are killed because of selfishness, ignorance and lies. Every time we save a baby is a victory," she says.


The most touching or meaningful thing she's experienced in her job is the look on the face of a baby's father when he hears the heartbeat and sees his child for the first time.

"The range of emotions, from shock to awe, can bring tears to my eyes," she says.

She says she loves that she gets to do the "fun part" of ultrasounds.

For those who may be unfamiliar with the center, she says she tells them it offers free resources and support to mothers and families, and shares the truth about abortion.

"They are always amazed at how much we offer by donations and volunteers," she says.
