JEREMIAH'S JOURNEY

My name is Jeremiah Daniel. I was born by emergency C-section on 11/15/21.

I wasn't always seen as a blessing and a joy to my mom and dad.

Let me start at the beginning. My mom came to the Pregnancy Center on April 21, 2021. She really wanted an ultrasound to "see" me. She wasn't sure what I was just yet. My mom wasn't even sure she wanted to keep me, and she didn't know if she wanted to give me life.

My mom sat and talked with Sonja and then met Bev for an ultrasound. Mom got to see me and see that I was a boy. A real boy, with 10 fingers and 10 toes, her nose and my dad's feet.

By the end of April my mom told Ms Annie that she was going to keep me and give me life.

Over the next few months mom and dad spent more time together and decided it was best for all of us to be a family under the same roof.

In July of 2021 my mom told everyone that she wanted me to have a biblical name because she made the decision to trust God with her life and mine.

By September of 2021 my dad started coming to the pregnancy center appointments with my mom.

That's my story. I hope that you can help other babies like me.

LOOKING BACK

Such a small space to cover so much from all of 2021 and the vision for 2022, so here it goes.

We were able to get 3 amazing fundraisers in for 2021, all very fruitful financially and relationally. We gained new donors and volunteers; we shared tears, laughter and some great food.

One of the most beautiful results from our fundraising efforts is the boutique that we built and staffed for our families to come in and get the necessary items they need to be successful, well provided for families. I can't describe the love that is tangible when guests enter and see what we have to help them at any and every stage of pregnancy which continues after the baby is born.

A huge shout of THANKS to the Knights of Columbus for our new ultrasound machine that has enabled us to show life to our moms and dads as early as 6 weeks!

So what are we looking at for 2022? I'm glad you asked.

We are at the final stages of adding the Binx STD testing equipment. We can do the tests, but we still are in need of a doctor to write the Rx for positive tests.

If you are an MD and are hoping to put your amazing education to another use, we are looking to become an APRN (Abortion Pill Rescue Network) center. Let me explain a bit; when a woman takes the first of the abortion pills, but decides not to continue with the termination of her child, she can get on a progesterone regiment to "reverse" (offset) the effects of the mifepristone. We have the early ultrasound capabilities to help with this process, but not the doctor to administer the progesterone.

As wonderful and amazing as 2021 was, I can't wait to see what God has in store for the Pregnancy and Family Resource Center for 2022!
